**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF THE GRANT APPLICATION BY THE ELGIN POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE SB-12 RIFLE-RESISTANT BODY ARMOR GRANT TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR**

**WHEREAS,** The City of Elgin finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Elgin, Texas, that the Rifle-Resistant Body Armor Grant be operated for 2019; and

**WHEREAS,** The City of Elgin agrees that there are no matching funds for the said project; and

**WHEREAS,** The City of Elgin agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, The City of Elgin assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

**WHEREAS,** The City of Elgin designates the Chief of Police as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.
