



Elgin City Council Meeting Agenda Item Executive Summary

ITEM: Review of stormwater drainage projects included within the Five-Year Capital Plan

DEPARTMENT: City Engineer

BACKGROUND:

This item is for an informational report and general discussion of all currently identified stormwater drainage projects included within the 2020 City of Elgin Five-Year Capital Plan (5YRCP).

The 5YRCP is a comprehensive document describing all currently proposed capital expenditures and projects for all city departments and operations for each of the next five years. The 5YRCP is designed to provide operations staff with the opportunity to look beyond the standard 12-month governmental funding cycle; while also providing City Council with information necessary to achieve effective long-term financial planning.

General discussion at a recent Council Meeting appeared to indicate some possible confusion regarding the identification of certain stormwater drainage improvement plans within the 5YRCP. This discussion will also provide an opportunity for Council to prioritize or re-prioritize the various projects, if so desired.
