ITEM: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

DEPARTMENT: Community Development Department / Utilities Department

PROPOSED ACTION: Authorize submission of a grant application for the 2019-2020 Texas Community Development Fund from the Texas Community Development Block Grant (TxCDBG) program of the Texas Department of Agriculture for water system improvements.

BACKGROUND: The City of Elgin plans to apply for a grant from the 2019-2020 Texas Community Development Fund from the Texas Community Development Block Grant (TxCDBG) program of the Texas Department of Agriculture. The water system improvement project is to expand an existing water line that runs from FM 1704 to Hwy 95 South along Fisher Street. This project meets the grant requirements and is expected to score well. This expansion will improve services in the immediate area.
