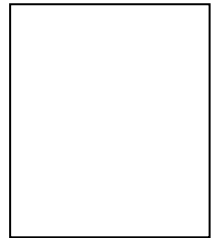

Reason for denial:

- Misrepresentation or false statement contained in the application for permit;
- A violation of any of the provision of this Article;
- Conviction of any crime involving moral turpitude;
- Conviction of any crime constituting a breach of the peace, or violation of any city ordinance or state law, when the incident constituting the basis of such crime occurred during the course of businesses as an itinerant vendor or peddler;
- The proposed operation would not comply with Federal law, State law or city ordinance, including zoning restrictions;

Inspections

- Failure to provide parking spaces, which need not be paved, sufficient in number to accommodate the number of automobiles being reasonably expected to be parked at any one time, taking into consideration the type, size and quantity of merchandise to be offered for sale, and in addition to those parking spaces required under the zoning ordinance for existing businesses;
- The use blocks access or driveway;
- Failure to provide adequate trash containers for the proposed use;
- Failure to comply with all the provisions of this Article; or
- Mental incompetence to a degree that the person is not held responsible for criminal actions in a court of law or is not competent to stand trial.
