

Elgin City Council Meeting Agenda Item Executive Summary

ITEM: AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND REGULATING A TRUCK TRAFFIC ROUTE WITHIN THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS; PROHIBITING TRUCK TRAFFIC ON LOOP 109/MAIN STREET; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500; AND PROVIDING FINDINGS OF FACT; REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE

DEPARTMENT: City Manager

PROPOSED ACTION:

Consideration and approval of an Ordinance formally establishing a Truck Route within the City.

BACKGROUND:

Discussed at previous meetings; Since early last year, the City has experienced a significant increase in in large trucks with oversized loads, primarily through Downtown Elgin on Main Street or Loop 109; causing a disruption of traffic and extensive damage to both public and private property.

At the request of City Council, the staff completed a review and generated a report that was presented to Council in November. Its conclusion was to consider establishing a Truck Route, that would require all large trucks carrying oversized loads to utilize US290; and that plan was endorsed by City Council.

Subsequently, the staff submitted a formal proposal to the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) requesting formal authorization for said Truck Route; and TxDOT has now approved this request. Adopting this Ordinance as now proposed is the final step in formally establishing the Truck Route and authorizing its legal enforcement.
