AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 42, ARTICLE IV. SOLID WASTE, REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS, , BY AMENDING CHAPTER 42 AND ADOPTING SECTION 42-277 REGARDING TRASH COLLECTION BY THE CITY; REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS:

I.

That Chapter 42, Section 42-277, Revised Code of Ordinances, City of Elgin, Texas, 2013, is hereby adopted to read as follows:

Sec. 42-277. – Trash Collection by the City.

The city or its contractor will collect garbage, rubbish and recycling from residential units once weekly and it shall be the duty of any person owning, occupying, managing, operating, leasing or renting any residential premises to place the trash carts and/or containers at the curb on the street prior to 7:00 a.m. on the day established for collection, but no earlier than 7:00 a.m. the day prior to the established collection day. Trash carts and/or containers shall be removed no later than 7:00 p.m. on the day after the collection day. Trash carts and/or containers shall be stored behind the front building wall of the residential structure when not placed out for collection.

II.

a) All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or resolutions in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

b) The invalidity of any section or provision of this ordinance shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.

c) The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this ordinance was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this ordinance and the subject matter hereof was discussed, considered and formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meeting Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.
