Council Member Penson moved to approve the Consent Agenda. Council Member Dennis seconds the motion. Motion carried 8-0.

**NEW BUSINESS**

1. A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING A COST PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT REGARDING THE CONSTRUCTION OF COUNTY LINE ROAD WITH LGI-HOMES-TEXAS, LLC AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS RELATED THERETO.

Council Member Brashar moved to approve the contract as presented. Council Member Penson seconds the motion. Motion carried 8-0.

2. (SECOND READING) AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2019, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LOCAL GOVT

CODE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS AND THE ORDINANCES AND RULES OF THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS; APPROPRIATING THE VARIOUS AMOUNTS THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Council Member Brashar moved that the Fiscal Year 2019-20 Operating Budget be adopted as proposed with revisions as stated regarding the:

- a. Cover page
- b. Authorized Position Listing
- c. Addition of the Budget or the EDC and
- d. Addition of the Budget for the TIRZ #1 as previously introduced and reviewed. Council Member Lopez seconds the motion. Motion carried 8-0.

3. (SECOND READING) AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS, FOR THE 2019-20 FISCAL YEAR; AND PROVIDING FOR THE INTEREST AND SINKING FUND FOR THE 2019 TAX YEAR.

Council Member Dennis moved that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of .0656916, which is effectively a 12.33 percent increase in the tax rate. Council Member Brashar seconds the motion. Motion carried 8-0.

4. AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A COMPREHENSIVE SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES NECESSARY TO GENERATE FUNDING FOR GENERAL AND SPECIFIC OPERATIONS REQUIRED TO SATISFY SERVICE NEEDS OF THE CITY; TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2013-12-03-30 AND SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS TO THAT ORDINANCE; ESTABLISH NEW CATEGORIES OF FEES AND CHARGES; REVISE EXISTING RATES; RECONFIRM EXISTING RATES; PROVIDE FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS; AND PROVIDE THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE AS STATED HEREIN.

Council Member Brashar moved to approve the Ordinance as presented. Council Member Penson seconds the motion. Motion carried 8-0.

5. AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS, AMENDING THE AMOUNT OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE GENERAL FUND AS WELL AS ALL OTHER FUNDS THAT PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF OPERATING AND CAPITAL EXPENDITURES AND BY CHANGING THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED FOR VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY AS ORIGINALLY ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2018-9-25-38 ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 25, 2018 AND AS AMENDED BY ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE NO.

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2019-05-15-34 ON MAY 15, 2019; IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS AND THE ORDINANCES AND RULES OF THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS; APPROPRIATING THE VARIOUS AMOUNTS THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH, AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Council Member Brashar moved to approve the Ordinance as presented. Council Member Lopez seconds the motion. Motion carried 8-0.
