



Elgin City Council Meeting Agenda Item Executive Summary

ITEM: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS NOMINATING UP TO FIVE PEOPLE TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF THE BASTROP CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS.

DEPARTMENT: Administration

PROPOSED ACTION: City of Elgin nomination to the BCAD.

BACKGROUND: The staff received the following notification from the BCAD last week:

Currently our Board of Directors is five (5) members. Each tax unit may nominate up to five individuals. Four of the current five members are willing to stand for re-election, leaving one vacancy. Mr. Bryan Bracewell has chosen not to seek another term with the Board of Directors. The four board members who have stated they would continue to serve if elected are Roderick Emanuel, Bill Hector, David Redd, and Dennis Snyder. The tax unit is not obligated to nominate a current member. The tax assessor collector is the sixth member of the board and is a nonvoting director.

Regarding nominations, I recommend reading the eligibility requirements as published in the Appraisal District Director's Manual, page 4, and available on the Comptroller's website.
